Utilizing %100 SCS certified pre-consumer recycled wood fiber as a raw material and manufacturing in a process that adds no urea formaldehyde, Roseburg has created a panel that can meet a number of environmental objectives.

As it is a wood based product, SkyBlend can be used in any application where conventional particleboard has typically been used. Fixtures, casework, cabinets and furniture are just some of the many uses for this product. Given the broad range of applications where SkyBlend is suitable, its greatest feature may very well be the wide range of finishes in which the product can be specified.
